The Arkansas Department of Education (ADE) Office of Educator Effectiveness (OEE) will host three (3) trainings for newly hired administrators. The first training is the **required** TESS/LEADS Law and Process training for all newly hired administrators who missed the fall three (3) hour training. This training will be on January 28, 2016, in Little Rock, from 8:30 am – 11:30 am and will cover teacher and administrator evaluation requirements of law, rules, and processes for implementation.

The second training is a Teachscape support training which is optional but highly recommended. This training will also be held in Little Rock on January 28, 2016, from 12:30 pm until 3:30 pm. This training will provide tips on using Teachscape and preparing for the evaluator proficiency assessment.

On February 11, 2016, the ADE will host a BloomBoard training for administrators in Little Rock from 8:30 am until 3:30 pm. This training is recommended for administrators who wish to gain experience on the administrative side of BloomBoard. The training will prepare administrators to conduct observations, collect and analyze evidence, and provide ratings.
