The application for charter is submitted by Jonesboro High School. The charter school would be The Academies at Jonesboro High School and would be located within Jonesboro High School at 301 Hurricane Drive, Jonesboro, AR. Students in grades 10 – 12 would be served at the school. The proposed enrollment cap would be no matter than 1800 students.

The purpose of the proposed charter school is to develop a high school with a focus on the Arkansas Department of Career and Workforce Education Career Clusters. The program will seek to provide a project based approach that serves student levels ranging from struggling learners to advanced placement. An integrated curriculum that promotes technology and promotes college and career readiness will be employed.

The district will make a decision regarding the final intent to make application within the required period.
