The Powerpoint International Corporation (PIC) hereby submits the Letter of Intent to apply for an Open-Enrollment Charter School with the Arkansas Department of Education. Doing business as a legal entity known as the Community Outreach Development Corporation (IRS: 501.C.3 identified as a non-profit corporation), and in collaboration with the Gateway-to-College Foundation, PIC intends to open Hi-TEC-Hi. PIC has assembled a community of stakeholders (inclusive of two-year and four-year colleges) with a vision to reach the masses of high school students who are in jeopardy of academic failure.

Hi-TEC-Hi School, which stands for High Technology Core Classes, High Experiential hands-on learning Classes, and Highly involved dual-enrollment College courses, is a proposed high school that maximizes the academic, affective, and intellectual potentials of high school students. The focus of the high school is driven by quantifiable results of student success. Frequent authentic assessment is intermittently interwoven throughout each student's program. Students will be pre-diagnosed upon enrollment utilizing assessment tools that determine present level of academic functioning, affective reasoning abilities, and intellectual interests. These results will initiate each student's prescriptive plans and drive their high school-to-college-career track.

Hi-TEC-Hi will have a main campus located in North Little Rock School District with satellite virtual campuses in Arkansas County (Dewitt School District), Bald Knob School District, and Pine Bluff School District. Hi-TEC-Hi School's main campus will house a maximum of 500 students in grades 9-12. The satellite schools will house a maximum of 100 students in grades 9-12.

The purpose of Hi-TEC-Hi will situate students who are at-risk of dropping out of school and those who have dropped out previously with solid support systems that undergird their individual success. Through the advisory program, students will be mentored from high school-to-college-to-career placement and two years thereafter. Hi-TEC-Hi is a proposed high school that will change the face of its students as it situates their lives for positive citizenry!
