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## **HOME SCHOOL REPORT 1997-98**

### Introduction

Act 400 of 1997 made changes in Arkansas Home School Laws. Responsibility for the implementing of Home School Laws shifted from the Arkansas Department of Education (ADE) to the local school districts and education service cooperatives. Major changes include:

The elimination of two (2) deadline dates of August 15 and December 15 for submitting Notice of Intent to Home School forms. Parents or guardians who choose to home school their children may submit, any time during the school year, a Notice of Intent to Home School form and a waiver form to the superintendent of their local school district. The waiver form authorizes the release of the State of Arkansas from any future liability for the education of their child.

Parents or guardians who move to Arkansas from another state during the school year and desire to home school or continue to home school their child/children must give written notice to the superintendent of the school district of residency. The Notice of Intent to Home School form, along with the waiver form, must be filed within thirty(30) days of establishing residency within the district.

Parents or guardians must deliver written notice in person to the superintendent of their local school district the first time such notice is given.

Home school students at grade level, or no more than two (2) years beyond the normal age for the appropriate grade, for which the state mandates norm-referenced tests for public school students shall be tested using a nationally recognized test selected by the State Board of Education.

The administration of tests required by home school students shall be done by the director of the education service cooperative or someone designated by the Department of Education. The cost of testing is to be absorbed by the Department of Education.

School districts have the authority to assess home school students who enroll or re-enroll in school districts to determine the appropriate grade assignment.

Home school students desiring a driver's license must present a notarized Notice of Intent to Home School form to the State Police in order to receive a driver's permit/license.

Each school district must send a copy of the Notice of Intent to Home School form to the Arkansas Department of Education.

## DATA SOURCES

Information for this report was generated from the Notice of Intent to Home School forms filled out by parents or guardians of home schooled students. Copies of the forms, as required by Act 400 of 1997, were submitted to the Arkansas Department of Education by the school districts for statistical purposes. Local Education Agency (LEA) numbers and education service cooperatives were taken from other Arkansas Department of Education documents and publications. The Student Information section of the home school form provided facts on student grade level completed.

Estimates of grade level completed are based on date of birth when incomplete information was submitted regarding grade level. On a few occasions, telephone calls were made to parents for verifying the accuracy of data.

**ACT 400 OF 1997**

**“AN ACT TO AMEND AND REPEAL VARIOUS SECTIONS OF  
THE ARKANSAS CODE ANNOTATED PERTAINING  
TO HOME-SCHOOLED STUDENTS.”**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:**

**SECTION 1.** Arkansas Code Annotated § 6-15-502 is amended to read as follows:

“6-15-502. Rules, regulations, and procedures for monitoring and enforcing provisions.

(a) The provisions of § 6-18-201(a) shall be self-executing, and the State Board of Education shall have no authority to promulgate rules, regulations, or guidelines for the enforcement or administration thereof.

(b) The State Board of Education is empowered to make such reasonable rules and regulations required for the proper administration of this subchapter which are not inconsistent with the intent of this subchapter.

**SECTION 2.** Arkansas Code Annotated § 6-15-503 is amended to read as follows:

“6-15-503. Prerequisites to home schooling.

(a)(1) Parents or guardians desiring to provide a home school for their children must give written notice to the superintendent of their local school district of their intent to provide a home school for their child and sign a waiver authorizing the release of the State of Arkansas from any future liability for the education of their child:

(A) At the beginning of each school year for parents who are currently homeschooling their child; or

(B) At the time during the school year that the parent withdraws the child from the local school district and at the beginning of each school year thereafter.

(2) Parents or guardians moving into the state during the school year who have home-schooled their children in another state must give written notice to the superintendent of their local school district of their intent to provide a home school for their child and sign a waiver authorizing the release of the State of Arkansas from any future liability for the education of their child within thirty (30) days of establishing residency within the district.

(3) Notice must include:

(i) The name, date of birth, grade level, and the name and address of the school last attended, if any, of each student involved; and

(ii) The location of the home school;

(iii) The basic core curriculum to be offered;

(iv) The proposed schedule of instruction; and

(v) The qualifications of the parent/teacher.

(4) Parents or guardians shall deliver written notice in person to the superintendent of their local school district the first time such notice is given.

(b) This information may be used only for statistical purposes, and test administration.

(c) Each local school district shall report the statistical data required by this section to the Department of Education each year."

**SECTION 3.** Arkansas Code Annotated § 6-15-504 is amended to read as follows:

"6-15-504. Home-schooled students - Achievement tests - Enrollment or re-enrollment in local schools.

(a) Each student enrolled in a home school program who is considered to be at a grade level, or no more than two (2) years beyond the normal age for the appropriate grade, for which the State mandates norm-referenced tests for public school students shall be tested using a nationally recognized achievement test selected by the State Board of Education.

(b)(1)(A) The administration of the tests required of home-schooled students shall be by the directors of the education service cooperatives established under § § 6-13-1001 et seq., or as otherwise designated by the Department of Education.

(B) For the purposes of this section, the superintendents of the Little Rock, North Little Rock, and Pulaski County school districts shall act in lieu of an education service cooperative director.

(2) The directors of the education service cooperatives shall establish a common set of procedures, approved by the Director of the Department of Education, for the proper administration of the tests required by this section.

(3) Such administration shall include purchasing the test materials, giving the tests, scoring and interpretation of the tests, and reporting test results.

(c) The cost of testing required by this section shall be the responsibility of the Department of Education when the tests are administered by the directors of the education service cooperatives or other Department of Education designees.

(d) Alternate testing procedures may be approved by the director of an education service cooperative after consultation with the parents of a home-schooled student; provided, however, that any costs associated with an alternate testing procedure shall be the responsibility of the parents.

(e)(1) Each local school district shall have authority to assess any home-schooled student who enrolls or re-enrolls in the district in order to determine proper educational placement.

(2) The local school district shall utilize, among other means of assessment, the norm-referenced test approved by the State Board of Education to assess the student and shall determine placement in the appropriate grade level as indicated by the test results.

(f) Any home-schooled student who enrolls or re-enrolls in a local school district must attend classes for at least nine (9) months immediately prior to graduation before the student can become eligible to receive a high school diploma from the district."

**SECTION 4.** Arkansas Code Annotated § 6-15-505 is repealed.

**SECTION 5.** Arkansas Code Annotated § 6-15-506 is repealed.

**SECTION 6.** Arkansas Code Annotated § 6-15-507 is amended to read as follows:

"6-15-507. Ineligibility of home schools for local, state, or federal funds.

Home schools authorized by this subchapter shall not be eligible for local, state, or federal funds allocated to a public school district."

**SECTION 7.** Arkansas Code Annotated § 27-16-701(d) is amended to read as follows:

"(d) Every application for an instruction permit or for a driver's license by a person less than eighteen (18) years old on October 1 of any year shall be accompanied by:

(1)(A) Proof of receipt of a high school diploma or its equivalent or enrollment and regular attendance in an adult education program or a public, private, or parochial school.

(i) A student enrolled in school shall present proof of a 'C' average for the previous semester or grading period in order to be issued a license.

(ii) A student with disabilities receiving special education or related services or a student enrolled in an adult education program shall present proof that the student is successfully completing his individual education plan in order to be issued a license.

(B) 'Regular attendance' in a school shall be attendance in compliance with the established written policy of the school district or school concerning truancy.

(C) 'Regular attendance' in an adult education program shall be attendance in compliance with the policy for sixteen (16) and seventeen (17) year olds established by the State Board of Vocational Education as provided for in § 6-18-222;

(2) Proof that such person is being provided schooling at home as described in § 6-15-501 et seq. in the form of a notarized copy of the written notice of intent to home school the student provided by the parent or guardian to the superintendent of the local school district as required by § 6-15-503.

(3) Proof that such person is enrolled in a postsecondary vocational-technical program, a community college, or a two-year or four-year institution of higher education.”

**SECTION 10. Repealing Clause**

**SECTION 11. Emergency.** It is found and determined by the General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the immediate implementation of this Act is necessary to clarify testing requirements for home-schooled students and is further necessary to efficient operation of the Arkansas Department of Education. Therefore an emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall become effective on the date of its approval by the Governor. If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides the veto.



## **Home Schools**

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**ADE**

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### **1.00 - REGULATORY AUTHORITY**

**1.01** - These regulations shall be known as Arkansas Department of Education Regulations governing Home Schools.

**1.02** - These regulations are enacted pursuant to the State Board of Education's authority under Ark. Code Ann. § 6-15-501 through 507 (Repl. 1993) as amended by Act 522 of 1995 and Act 400 of 1997.

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### **2.00 - PURPOSE**

**2.01** - It is the purpose of these regulations to set the reasonable guidelines for the operation of Home Schools.

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### **3.00 - DEFINITIONS**

**3.01** - For the purposes of these Rules and Regulations, a "home school" is a school conducted primarily by parents or legal guardians for their own children.

**3.02** - For the purposes of these Rules and Regulations, a "testing window" is an established testing calendar as determined by the Arkansas Department of Education.

**3.03** - For the purposes of these Rules and Regulations, "alternate testing procedures" refers to any testing date(s) and/or location(s) within the testing window and approved by the education service cooperatives and Pulaski County school districts for home school students.

**3.04** - For the purposes of these Rules and Regulations, "a norm-referenced test (NRT)" is any testing instrument required by state law, rule or regulation to measure the performance/achievement of Arkansas students relative to the performance of the achievement of students who comprise the norming or standardization group for a particular commercial instrument.

**3.05** - For the purposes of these Rules and Regulations, an "individualized education program (IEP)" is a written record of decisions reached between parent/guardian and school personnel

jointly describing the educational program for a child with a disability.

**3.06** - For the purposes of these Rules and Regulations, "current school year" is the official period of time for pupil teacher interaction within the school district policy which follows the guidelines in Ark. Code Ann. § 6-10-106 (Uniform dates for beginning and ending a school year.).

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#### **4.00 - GENERAL**

**4.01** - Under Arkansas law children between the ages of five (5) and seventeen (17), inclusive in accordance with Ark. Code Ann. § 6-18-201 (statute referencing the compulsory attendance age requirement) must attend school.

**4.02** - For the purpose of this Act, a parent/guardian who intends to home school a child in accordance with Ark. Code Ann. § 6-18-201 must enroll the child in home school within ten (10) days of, or before, the first day of the current school year or at any time during the school year the parent/guardian withdraws the child from the local school district. Any parent/guardian who withdraws a student from public, private or parochial school any time during the school year shall file an Intent to Home School form and Waiver form with the superintendent of the local school district. These forms shall be filed within ten (10) days of withdrawal from the public, private or parochial school. As described in Section Five (5) in these Rules and Regulations, any student entering home schooling during the school year shall participate in the required State testing program at the required grade levels.

**4.03** - Parent/guardian may elect for a child, who will not be kindergarten age in accordance with Ark. Code Ann. § 6-18-201, not to attend kindergarten by filing a Kindergarten Waiver form with the local school district administration office.

**4.04** - A home school is defined as a school conducted primarily by parents or legal guardians for their own children.

**4.05** - Home school students who enroll in a public, private or parochial school during the time they are home schooling cannot re-enter home schooling until new Notice of Intent and Waiver forms are completed and returned to the local school district.

**4.06** - Home school students who are in the required grade levels for which the state mandates norm-referenced testing and who are no more than two (2) years beyond the normal age for the required grade levels must take a standardized norm-referenced test as identified by the Arkansas Department of Education and results will be used for reporting purposes only.

**4.07** - Books, curricula or materials are not furnished by the Arkansas Department of education, local school district or education service cooperative. It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to purchase all books, curricula or materials that they use in home schooling.

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## **5.00 - NOTICE OF INTENT**

**5.01** - Parents or Guardians who plan to home school must file written notice by completing and returning the printed current year Notice of Intent and Waiver forms to the public school superintendent's office of their local school district within ten (10) days of, or before, the first day of the current school year or at any time during the school year that the parent/guardian withdraws the child(ren) from the local school district. Parent/guardian who withdraws their child(ren) during the school year must complete a current year printed Notice of Intent and Waiver forms within ten (10) days of, or before, the beginning of the school year thereafter. There are no exceptions to these filing requirements except as outlined in 5.02.

**5.02** - Any student(s) home schooled in another state prior to moving to Arkansas during the current school year may continue in a home school if the parent(s) or guardian(s) file the current year printed Notice of Intent and Waiver forms with their local public school superintendent's office within thirty (30) school days.

**5.03** - The required Notice of Intent and Waiver forms must be the printed current year forms obtained from your local superintendent's office and must include the following information for reporting and test administration purposes only:

- a. The name, date of birth and grade level of each child and the name and attended, if any, for each student.
- b. The location of the home school (your mailing address) and phone number.
- c. A brief description of the basic core curriculum to be used and the subjects to be taught.
- d. Schedule of instruction to be followed (hours per day; days per week; number of weeks).
- e. The education qualifications of the parent/guardian/teacher(s).
- f. Parents or guardians shall deliver written notice in person to the superintendent of their local school district the first time such notice is given.

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## **6.00 - TESTING REQUIRED**

### **6.01 - ACHIEVEMENT TESTS**

- a. Test administration of home school students shall be under the direction of the education service cooperatives and the Pulaski County school districts. Achievement testing will be held during the testing window identified by the Arkansas Department of Education.
- b. The education service cooperatives and Pulaski County school districts will ensure that all test materials are secure before testing, between and following test administration and provide the Arkansas Department of Education, for

approval by the Director, with a common set of procedures for test administration of home school students in the required grade levels. These common set of procedures must include security measures to ensure that appropriate testing conditions and protocol have been followed as specified in the test administration materials.

c. Each student enrolled in home school who is considered to be in the required grades or no more than two (2) years beyond the age appropriate grade will be tested by using the State identified norm-referenced achievement test.

d. Parents/guardians or groups of home school parents/guardians requesting alternate testing procedures, protocols, locations and/or timeframe must be submitted in writing three (3) weeks prior to the testing window to the education service cooperatives or the Pulaski County school districts and testing must remain within the State identified testing dates. If approved, alternate testing procedure costs, other than the testing materials, shall be the responsibility of the parent/guardian.

e. Alternate testing procedures and protocol will be arranged by the education service cooperatives and Pulaski County school districts.

f. Requests from parent/guardian whose child(ren) cannot test on Saturdays due to religious reasons will be accommodated. Parent/ guardians must indicate in the appropriate section at the time they file their Notice of Intent that their child(ren) cannot test on Saturdays due to religious reasons.

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## **7.00 - TEST RESULTS**

7.01 - Test results for home school students will be used for reporting purposes only. The parent/guardian will receive the individual student profile. The Arkansas Department of Education will receive the administrative summaries. The administrative summaries will not contain personally identifiable information.

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## **8.00 - TRANSFER OF STUDENTS**

8.01 - Students transferring from a home school to a school which is accredited by the Arkansas Department of Education shall be evaluated by the staff of the accredited school to determine proper placement. As part of the ongoing assessment process, a State identified norm-referenced achievement test shall be one of the instruments utilized.

8.02 - Home Schools are not accredited by the Arkansas Department of Education. There are no grades, credits, transcripts or diploma provided by the Arkansas Department of Education, education service cooperative or by the local school district for students enrolled in home school.

8.03 - Any home school student who re-enters a local school

district must attend classes for at least nine (9) months immediately prior to graduation before the student can become eligible to receive a high school diploma from the local school district.

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#### **9.00 - STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES**

**9.01** - By way of these regulations, it shall be the policy of the State Board of Education that school districts provide a genuine opportunity (see 34 C.F.R. Sec. 76.651(a)) to students who are home-schooled with disabilities, as defined in state regulations, to access special education and related services from the district where they reside. This policy is not to be construed as conferring the procedural protections and rights under Part B of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) to such students and their parent/ guardians.

**9.02** - Each student with disabilities in the required grades who participates in the norm- referenced testing program shall, upon notification in the application for testing, be eligible for any or all modifications allowed by the test procedures. The use of such modifications will be approved by the educational services cooperative director or his designee.

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#### **10.00 - DRIVER'S PERMIT/LICENSE**

**10.01** - A student enrolled in a home school shall present proof of home schooling in the form of a notarized copy of the Notice of Intent along with an application for an instructional permit or drivers license. The parent/guardian has the responsibility of providing the notarized copy.


