471000	World History Since 1450	Time frame - World History is no longer a survey course from the beginning of civilization to the present; the course now begins in 1450 and goes to the present; content is organized using National Center for History eras
470000	United States History Since 1890	Time frame – United States History is no longer a survey course from pre-Colonial America to the present; the course now begins in 1890 and goes to the present; content is organized using National Center for History eras
472000	Civics (.5 credit)	Prerequisite for United States Government
474300	Economics (.5 credit)	No change in time frame or prerequisites
473000	Arkansas History 9-12 (.5 credit)	Content is organized using Encyclopedia of Arkansas eras/timeline
474400	Psychology (.5 credit)	No change in time frame or prerequisites
474500	Sociology (.5 credit)	No change in time frame or prerequisites
474600	World Geography (.5 credit)	No change in time frame or prerequisites
474100	United States Government (.5 credit)	Civics is the prerequisite for this course
474700	African American History (.5 credit)	New course
378720	Arkansas History 7-8	Format of course has changed to mirror Grades K-6 organization of social studies by content areas (geography, civics, economics, and history)
377710	Social Studies Grade 7	Emphasis of Grade 7 Social Studies shifts from world history to world geography
388710	Social Studies Grade 8	Emphasis of Grade 8 Social Studies shifts from world history to United States history (1800-1900)
355710	Social Studies Grade 5	Organization of content areas (civics, economics, geography, and history) follows historical time frame United States History from Beginnings Through Formation of the New Nation (roughly ending at 1800)
366710	Social Studies Grade 6	Organization of content areas (civics, economics, geography, and history) follows historical time frame World History from Beginnings of Civilization Through 1450
204710	K-4 Social Studies	History strand develops discipline-specific skills (chronology, change over time, contextualization, perspective, historical evidence, and causation)
