Arkansas Standards Review of Mathematics and ELA

Arkansas Educators

- 170 Arkansas educators participated in the ELA and Math revision process
- 49 counties and 94 school districts were represented
- 32 content specialists participated
- 7 higher education representatives participated
- 63% of respondents were the parent or grandparent of a school-aged child
- 3,439 total responses to three public surveys were considered
- 1,416 responses to the general survey were considered
- 15 public meetings live-streamed

Arkansas Mathematic Standards

- 65% of mathematics standards were revised or clarified
 - 95% Kindergarten
 - 45% 1st Grade
 - 51% 2nd Grade
 - 53% 3rd Grade
 - 57% 4th Grade
 - 88% 5th Grade
 - 72% 6th Grade
 - 79% 7th Grade
 - 75% 8th Grade
 - 62 % High School
- 5 new standards were added
- 1,137 responses to the mathematics survey were considered
- 9 days of math revision meetings were live streamed (54 hours)
- New community feedback survey was released January 2016
- 3,157 responses to the community feedback survey
- Math specialists and educators reviewed feedback and applied edits if needed
- High School courses will be developed and released once standards are approved
