<p>Students ARE public school students and have Arkansas Licensed teachers</p>	<p>The charge for each course is determined by the provider The teachers for some courses may not be licensed Apex Learning, Inc.</p>	<p>Students ARE public school students enrolled in the public charter school</p>	<p>Students ARE NOT public school students, and parents annually complete Notice of Intent to Home School forms</p>
