# 2016-2017 District and School Indicators

## The Process

### **(Non Priority and Focus)**

- Conduct a comprehensive diagnostic analysis/ needs assessment to include reviewing 2015-2016 Objectives and Tasks to determine overall needs
- Re-Task as appropriate the 2015-2016 Indicators where needed for continued implementation toward full implementation as defined by WiseWays® research (This becomes a part of the 2016-2017 plan)
- Begin with aligning Indicators of effective practice to the needs identified in the needs assessment to assess, plan, and monitor and continue the process for the 2016-2017 school year



## 2016-2017 District and School Indicators (Non Priority and Focus)

- The state may ask districts for a particular Indicator to assess related to the diagnostic analysis/ needs assessment but for the most part, districts will provide guidance to schools based on the needs assessment.
- In order to have a plan, a school must be working to improve some component of the educational process within the ACSIP (Indistar) Indicators.
- Title I Schoolwide Schools must annually review the Indicators aligned to the Title I Schoolwide components.  
**(Further clarification will be provided within the Indistar system.)**

# Where are we now?

## 2015-2016 Program Evaluations

- This is a program evaluation for each source of funds that supported the school.
- Reference back to the needs assessment and goals from the beginning of the implemented plan.
- Identify the Source of Funds for Program Evaluation. ( i.e., Title I, Title II, NSL)
- Make a list of initiatives and activities supported by the source of funds. (i.e., human capital, programs and processes, professional development, contracted services, and family and community engagement)
- List the ACSIP Goals supported by the above components. (If there were no supported Goals listed in ACSIP, determined goals for the next needs assessment cycle.

# 2015-2016 Program Evaluations

- What types of data determined the outcomes of the use of human capital, programs and processes, professional development, contracted services, and family and community engagement above? (i.e., Surveys, reports, rubrics, observation, etc.)
- Are the above components of the source of funds accomplishing what we intended to do? What were the results?
  - If not and a different outcome was achieved, what does research recommend moving forward?
- If the initiatives will continue, what other information is needed to expand the evaluation to include prescriptive tasks ahead.

# **2016-2017 Needs Assessment**

- **Established Leadership Team / Instructional Teams**
- **Review the previous year's program evaluation results to determine outcomes of implemented programs and indicators.**
- **Clarify vision, mission, values and goals**
- **Prioritize and focus interventions/indicators to meet the identified needs to support the goals**
- **Assess the current reality of the indicators**
- **Review research to determine effective practices related to identified needs**
- **Identify the data, research, and resources needed to close the gap between the current reality and description of full implementation**
- **Determine what student-focused learning systems must be in place to support the needs**
