The state's annual Educators Career Fair will be held from 9 a.m. to noon on Saturday, April 16, at the Metroplex/Team Summit Event Center, 10800 Colonel Glenn Road, in Little Rock. The event is sponsored by the Arkansas Department of Education.

The fair will help licensed Arkansas educators who are looking for employment or other opportunities, such as adding subject areas to current licenses, renewing expired teaching licenses or earning advanced degrees.

"This event is designed to give Arkansas teachers the information and tools that they need to advance their credentials and careers," said Camille Sterrett with the department's Office of Teacher Recruitment. "We're also very active in trying to attract teachers from other states to teaching jobs in Arkansas."

The department will offer information on how teachers from other states can receive an Arkansas license. The department has advertised in states with layoffs of teachers in hope of filling key openings in Arkansas schools.

In addition to consulting with representatives from the ADE, attendees will have the opportunity to learn more about financial aid, colleges with education programs, and open positions with Arkansas school districts.
