## **ADE to Hold Annual Become an Arkansas Teacher Event Nov. 10**

**LITTLE ROCK** — Those interested in becoming teachers are encouraged to attend the Arkansas Department of Education's Become an Arkansas Teacher event. This free event will be held from 3 p.m. to 7 p.m. Nov. 10 at the Benton Event Center, 17322 Interstate 30, Benton.

This event is for high school and college students and those with non-education degrees who are thinking about becoming a teacher. Because there are multiple routes to becoming a licensed teacher, everyone is welcome to attend. Those who attend will have the opportunity to meet with ADE and college and university representatives to learn more about traditional licensure programs, as well as teacher certification master's degree programs and ADE's Arkansas Professional Pathway to Educator Licensure (APPEL) program, or non-traditional licensure program. An Arkansas Workforce Center mobile unit also will be onsite to assist with job searches.
